Room & Board Costs (Select Programs Only)

Students attending certain programs pay room and board costs to the study abroad partner. Examples are programs in the Pacific, or upgrades to the standard housing options. Review the partner program website for estimates.

Possible Costs WHILE Abroad (not charged to USI Bursar account)

Local Transportation

Varies by location and city size. Budget \$30 per week.

Meals

If a meal plan is not included in the program, budget \$75 per week for groceries. Buying groceries and cooking tends to be cheaper than eating out at restaurants.

Textbooks

Estimate what you would normally spend on books each semester. Inquire if textbooks are free to check out at the host institution library.
