2024-2025 Scholarship Information and Application

Application deadline February 09, 2024 (No later than 4:00 pm CST)

DETAILS OF AWARD

Ten \$1500 awards will be given to USI students registered with Disability Resources. To encourage participation from a variety of majors, there will be at least one recipient from each college/division that has at least three qualified applicants. The remaining scholarships will be awarded based on quality of materials submitted regardless of college/division.

Selection Process: The selection committee will review each application based on the materials submitted, in accordance with the required items. Once all the qualifications are met, the selection committee will then make the selection based on the quality of organized thought and originality of the essay and the letters of recommendation. The chosen recipients will be notified by April 2024.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for the EpiHab Scholarship, the applicant:

- x Is currently enrolled at USI and registered with Disability Resources
- x Enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours at USI during the Spring 2024 semester
- x Has completed or transferred to USI, a minimum of 12 credit hours.
- x Has a minimum cumulative 62 (or 30) TA work hours (10 work hours) toward educational expenses incurred at USI including tuition, course fees, textbooks, and housing. Each recipient has a maximum of four calendar years in which to use the award (from the first registration period following the award), recipients will be able to utilize the award beginning with the fall semester of 2024, but not before.

Please Note: The scholarship award will not cover expenses incurred prior to the scholarship.
